

2010 LOTA CLASSIC

Save the dates and mark your calendars! September 10, 11 and 12 are the dates for our second annual LOTA CLASSIC doubles tournament. We have coordinated the dates with Reynolds Plantation Lake Club who has generously offered to host this event. There will be a combination of clay and hard courts available.

The tournament will be open to everyone eighteen years and over. We hope to draw from a broad spectrum of regions with the goal of offering multiple divisions (levels of ability) for both men and women. There will be a registration fee of \$40.00 per person with a guarantee of each team playing at least twice. The format will be best of three-set matches (seven point tie-break at six games all) with a winners' bracket and a consolation bracket. The consolation bracket format will be an eight-game pro set (except for the final). The draw will be posted on Thursday, September 9th, and match play will begin on Friday morning.

T-shirts will be given to all participants and fruit and beverages will be provided during play. Participants must be available to play starting Friday morning at 8:00 through Sunday afternoon finals. Each person registered to play will be given a raffle ticket for prizes to be drawn at the Friday evening party. The winners and runners-up of each division and the winner of the consolation bracket will receive a trophy.

The registration form will be available at the LOTA website, www.LOTAtennis.com, and at the Reynolds Plantation Lake Club tennis shop.

The party will be held Friday evening at the Reynolds Plantation Marina Pavilion beginning at 6:00 p.m. and will include a catered dinner and dancing to our local talented and rocking Deraney Band. Tournament participants must pay an additional \$20.00 fee to bring a non-playing guest to the party.
